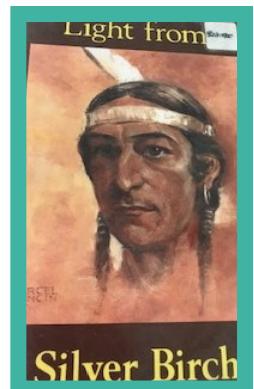
## Book Nook - with Vera
